In addition, the department strongly recommends that students take **4 semesters of a language spoken African Diaspora** (e.g., Arabic, French, Portuguese, Spanish, or an African Language).*



Requirements for a Minor in Africana Studies



For the Africana Studies minor, students must complete **seven courses in Africana Studies**, two of which must be the two-semester **AF10A&B** courses and **five other Africana Studies** courses that represent at least **three** academic disciplines (e.g., psychology, sociology, etc).
