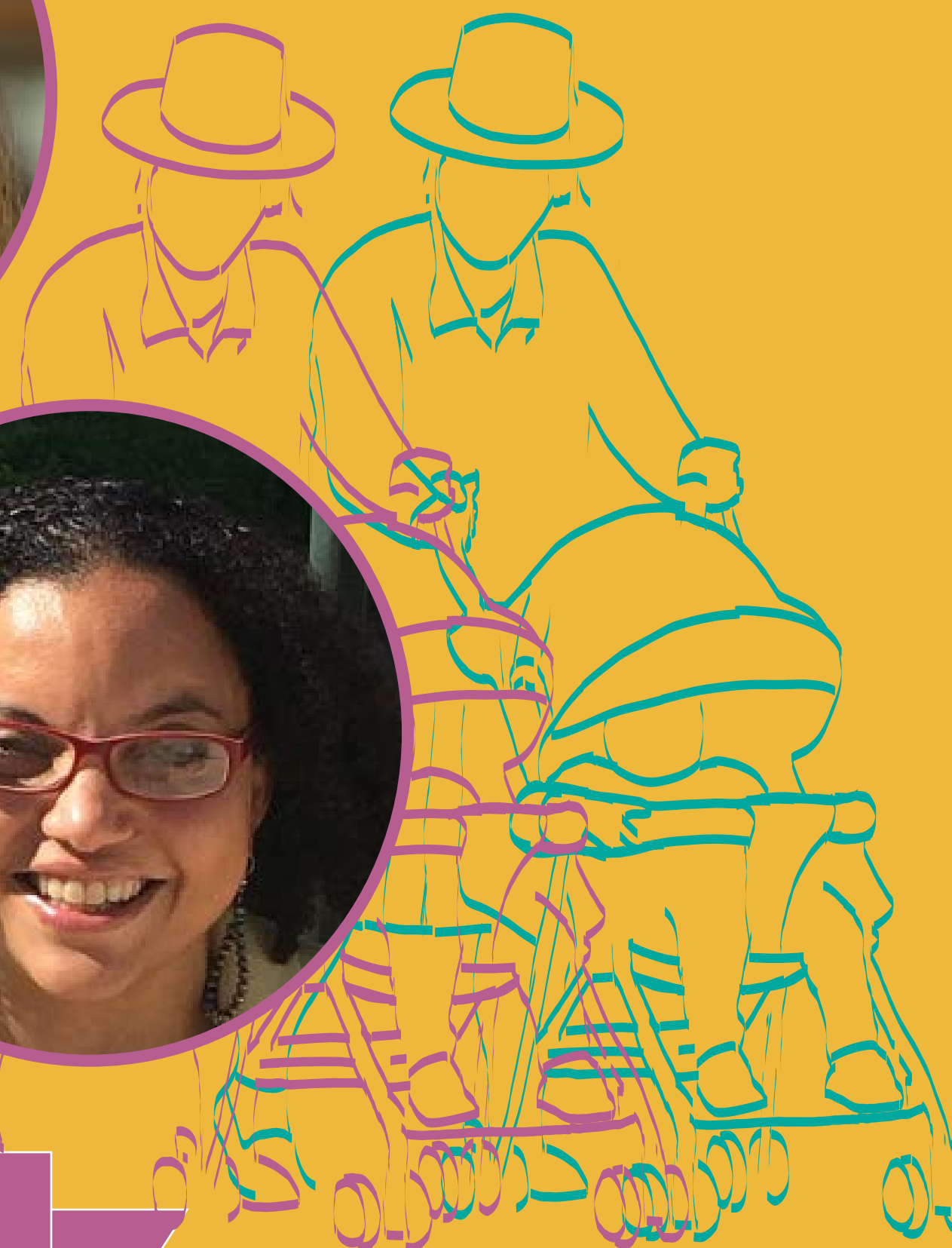


'Economies of Motherhood': Reproductive Justice in a Globalizing World
